Multiple laps on a 12-mile loop that runs down Broad Street, a right on to Payne Street, a left onto East Lake Road, a right onto Rockwell Road, straight onto Hill Road, straight onto Newton Road, straight onto Bonney Road, a left onto Hill Road, a right onto Chappel Road, straight onto Poolville Road, a right onto Hamilton Road, straight onto Hamilton Street, and a right back on to Broad Street.

Masters must be at least at USCF Cat 4.

Multiple laps on a 0.7-mile loop that runs down Broad Street, a right onto Payne Street, a right onto University Avenue, a right onto Hamilton Street, and then a right back onto Broad Street. The number of laps would be determined by age.

Race Information

The 2nd Annual Colgate Fall Classic has built upon the successes of the 1st Colgate Fall Classic. We have kept the course the same, hired local police to manage traffic around the start/finish, and increased signage prior to the turns in order to increase safety. We have also been able to make this year's prize list bigger and better than last year's.

We hope that those who joined us last year will return and spread the word about our growing race. In order to thank the returning racers for their support, we would like to offer a \$2 rebate in race entry fees on race day, whether you register online or on race day. So, be sure to let us know that this is your second year at the Colgate Fall Classic!!!

\$15 entry fee per rider for the Colgate University Hill Climb Time Trial
\$25 entry fee per rider for the Payne Valley Circuit Road Race
\$35 entry fee per rider for both races (a \$5 savings!!!)

Discounted pre-registration at BikeReg.com until Friday, September 14 at 5:00 PM EST. Race day registration will include a \$5 late fee per rider per race. It will start at 9:00 AM and will close one half-hour prior to the start of the race in which one is entering. This will take place at Adventure Bikes and Boards.

USCF rules apply. All entrants must possess a USCF license or Men Cat 5 and Women Cat 4 can purchase a one-day USCF license for \$10. Fees include \$2 USCF insurance.

Travel Information

The Colgate Fall Classic start/finish line will be on the east side of the Village Green, which is across from Adventure Bikes and Boards at 2 Broad Street, Hamilton, NY. Directions to the race can be found using Google Maps.

Parking for the event will be in the parking lot next to the Colgate University football stadium. To get to the stadium parking: go south on 12B (take a right out of the Adventure Bikes and Boards entrance), at the second traffic light take a right onto College Street, and then take a left into the area sealed off by the chain-linked fence behind the stadium seats.
